WHEREAS the migration and integration of legacy data from <a href="www.aces.gov.in">www.aces.gov.in</a> to <a href="www.cbic-gst.gov.in">www.cbic-gst.gov.in</a> is taking place, the ACES application will remain disabled. To provide adequate window to the taxpayers to file prescribed returns, it has been decided to extend the efiling time limits for filing such returns due in April 2019.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (6) of rule 12 read with sub-rule (3) of rule 23 of the Central Excise Rules 2017 and sub rule 5 of rule 11 of CENVAT Credit Rule, 2017, the period for filing of ER-1/ER-2 returns for the month specified below in columns 3 is extended the date mention in column 5.
